- 1. Ask the ward staff to contact the Chaplaincy to ask for a Roman Catholic chaplain. In an emergency this will be done immediately OR
- 2. For families and friends or before coming in for a planned stay in hospital, contact the chaplaincy on 020 8296 2306 or email Chaplains@esth.nhs.uk or inform your parish priest who will contact Father Philip Pak or the chaplaincy office.
