Blessed John Henry Newman - This Sunday 13th October, Blessed John Henry Newman will be canonised in St Peter's Square in Rome by Pope Francis. This will make him the first English Saint in modern times. He was declared venerable by St Pope John Paul II in 1991 and was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI in Birmingham in 2010. He is widely considered to be one of the most significant thinkers and writers of the 19th century.
