## Reception applications for September 2020 (Children born between 01.09.15 and 31.08.16.

Parents who wish to apply for a Reception class place for their child at St Teresa's Primary School for September 2020, are reminded that the closing date for applications is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020. There are two parts to the application process as follows:
