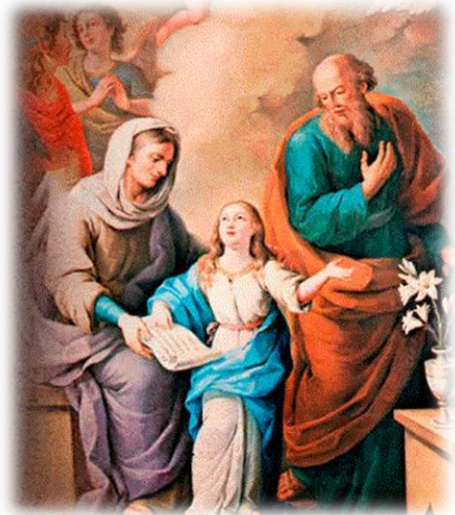

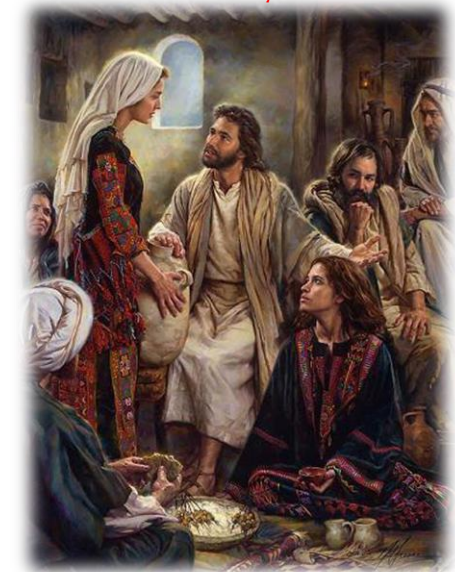

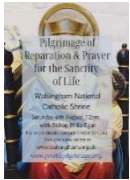
**LEGION OF MARY** The Legion of Mary meet Thursday evening 7pm in the Parish Centre.

Pope Francis will preside over the beatification Mass in St. Peter's Square on Sunday, 4 September 2022.
