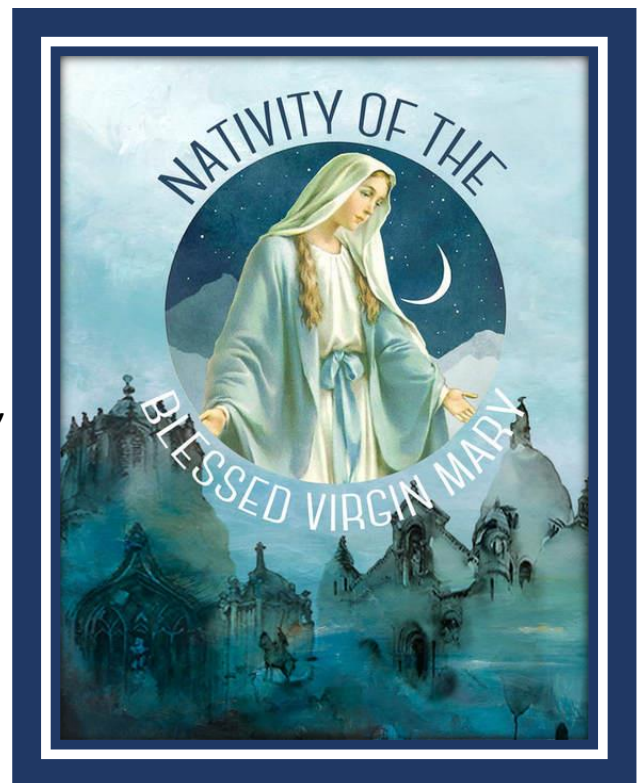

Pope Francis will preside over the beatification Mass in St. Peter's Square on Sunday, 4 September 2022.
