Many of the parish leads in the Deanery will attend a short course, called Discovery, which is promoted by the Diocese. St.Teresa's will run this course during Lent on Fridays over six weeks starting 24th Feb. Anyone who is involved in catechesis, and who is interested in attending this course should let the Parish Office know (quickly as it is only one week away and numbers are strictly limited).
