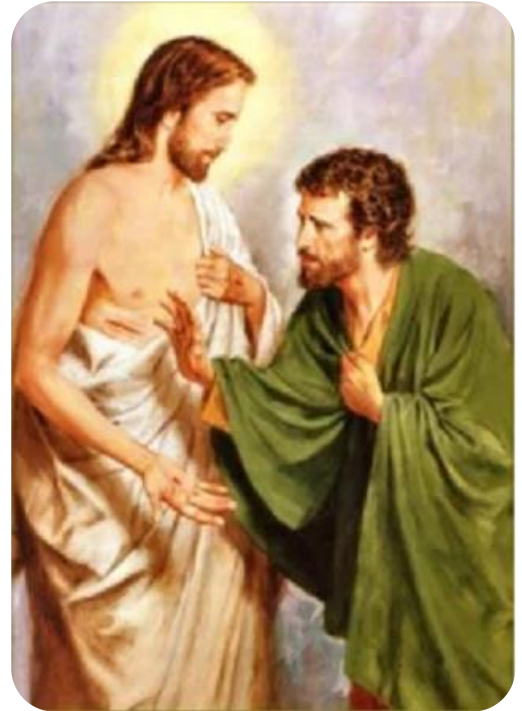

The other card reader for candles is situated in the narthex near the statue of St Teresa and can be used only for candles. The Repository can now accept payments by card as well as cash.
